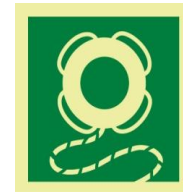
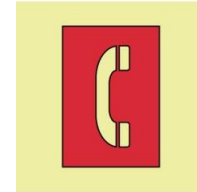
Overview

- IMO symbols provide easy to understand graphical instructions in the event of an emergency to ensure all passengers understand the directions
- Signs are photoluminescent for easy viewing in low light conditions
- Signs are adaptable for naval or commercial maritime use



Overview

- Signs are available in two materials
 - Pressure Sensitive Vinyl & Rigid Plastic
- Signs are laminated to prevent water damage and fading
- Three styles of symbols
 - Fire Control Plan
 - Life Saving and Rescue
 - Emergency Equipment and Embarkation Stations
- Combine label with letters or numbers to specify location



IMO Regulations

- Signs comply with:
 - IMO Resolution A.952(23) Shipboard Fire Control Plans - the use of international symbols for shipboard fire control plans would greatly increase their usefulness, both for the crew of the ship and for shore-based fire brigades
 - IMO Resolution A.760(18) Life Saving Appliances and Arrangements – Symbols indicating the locations of emergency equipment and muster/embarkation stations
